



# NEVADA PFS SPARS REPORTING 2021-22

## A Summary of 2021-22 Community Outcomes

### Abstract

This brief provides the Community Outcomes data for the Strategic Plan Goals and Objectives that replaced the six State Outcomes reported as community outcomes by the 10 PFS funded coalitions across Nevada.

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## **FY-2021 Summary**

As noted in the State Outcomes Report for FY-2022, the baseline data for the Nevada PFS program collected as part of the Nevada YRBS and YRBSS conducted by the CDC was not administered as planned as result of COVID-19 impacts. Currently, the Nevada YRBS data is available and was utilized for the State Outcomes Report, while the CDC YRBSS data will not be available publicly until Spring of 2023. Compared to the previous year report, this Community Outcomes Report presents the Strategic Plan (Feb 2021) Goals and Objectives with notation of reported data from the 10 Prevention Coalitions funded with PFS funding awards across Nevada. The collected Community Outcome data was gathered using an online survey in which the Prevention Coalitions were asked to report outcome data for each of the relevant goals and objectives as aligned with the Strategic Plan (Feb 2021) with total service or reach data wherever possible. The data collected was also focused on identifying data from both EBPPPs (off-the-shelf or out-of-the-box) and modified or locally developed EBPPP waiver programs that are aligned with EBPPP literature, but do not abide by the full curriculum or programming structure from an off-the-shelf or out-of-the-box EBPPP.

These modified or waiver EBPPPs are being reviewed by the Evidence Based Programs, Policies, and Practices Active Workgroup (EBPPPAW) that was created in Nevada to support and facilitate the implementation, administration, and evaluation of EBPPPs at higher standards of fidelity across multiple funding streams in Nevada. As reported in other related reports and data files for FY-2022, there were some issues with collecting EBPPP and non-EBPPP data for the EBPPP and Community Outcomes Survey reporting in SPARS. Additionally, FY-2022 was the first year of implementation that incorporated the updated Strategic Plan Goals and Objectives. As a result, the EBPPP and non-EBPPP reported data was only gathered and categorized at the

Strategic Plan Goal lens of analysis. In FY-2023, there will be further reporting expectations communicated to the Prevention Coalitions as part of the FY-2023 reporting training and Technical Assistance, which will seek to continue to improve Nevada's capacity to report on specific measurable outcomes at the individual, program, Prevention Coalition, region, and state levels. The EBPPP and non-EBPPP data are listed directly under the relevant Strategic Plan Goal as applicable with specific objective information listed subsequently. As noted above, FY-2023 reporting will seek to expand the Annual Evaluation Report scope to include alignment of programming both EBPPPs and non-EBPPPs to Strategic Plan Goals and corresponding Strategic Plan Objectives.
