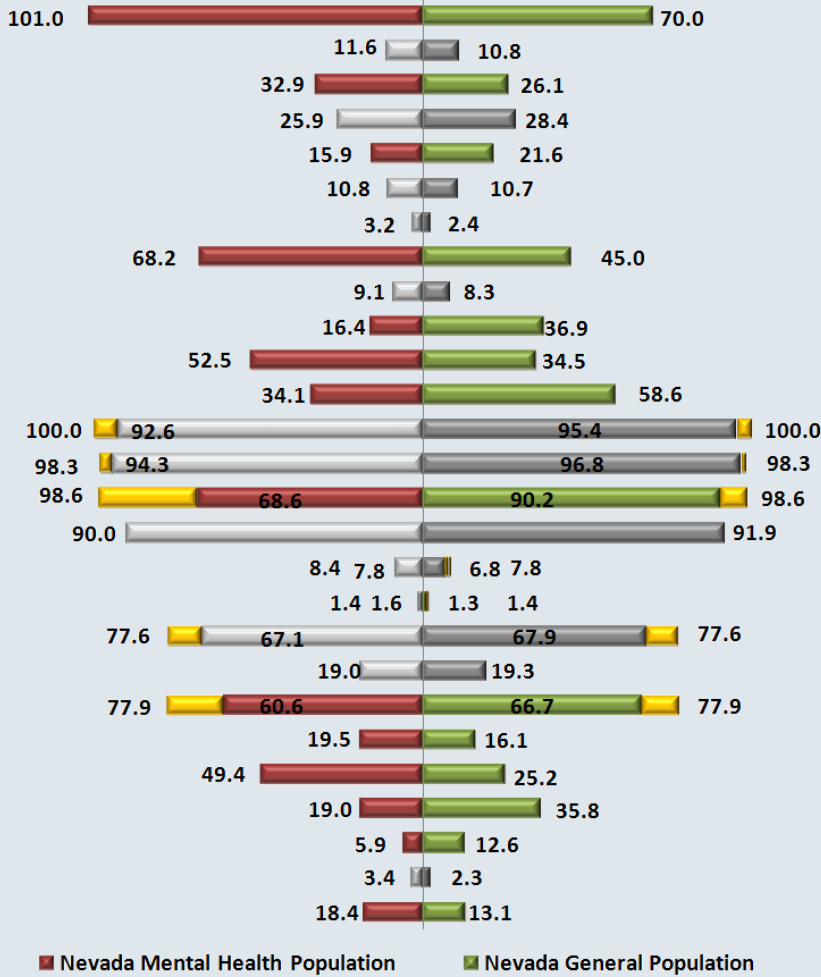

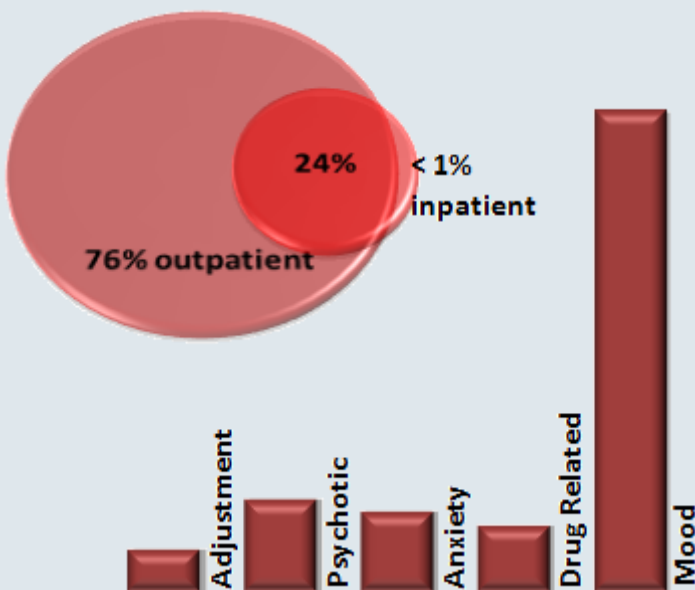

- ↑ prenatal care beginning later in pregnancy
- ↑ rate of adverse birth outcomes
