


Service Description	24 hour facility for adults in crisis-including mental health and substance abuse crisis Length of stay 3-5 days	Provides services in their home for individuals with chronic medical and serious mental health conditions that require rehabilitative and habilitative services. Timeframe 6-24 months.	Provides intensive services for individuals who need support with behavioral skills training, self-care training, medication management, intensive supervision and overnight supervision. Timeframe 6-12 months.	Provides services for individuals with training for independent skills, psychosocial rehabilitation, and limited supervision. Timeframe 6-12 months.	A federally funded permanent supportive housing program for consumers capable of independent living. Temporary housing for homeless persons that were in acute crisis and ready to be released from the hospital or forensic settings. Timeframe- up to 3 months/90 days.	A supportive housing program for consumers capable of independent living. Individuals in the Dual Success program have graduated from the Total Recovery Program and are need after care programming in supportive housing environment. Timeframe- up to 24 months.	Able to live independently with some rental support from state. No wrap around services needed. Timeframe-varies based upon individuals.	Provides services for co-existing medical and mental health disorders that require 24 hours of medical management and support. Timeframe-varies based upon individuals.	Provides services that require 24 hours of supervision and assistance for adult living skills and medication management. Timeframe-6-12 months.	A specialized therapeutic group home for individuals that have a diagnosis of a serious mental illness and a substance abuse diagnosis. Timeframe-90 days & then transition into Dual Success.	A supportive housing program for consumers capable of independent living. This program creates housing for people that are homeless and with disabilities by providing rental subsidies for up to 5 years to a homeless household receiving an equal amount of services from a provider. Timeframe- up to 24 months.	Geriatric long term care for individuals with dementia or serious mental illness. Services provided include: medical care, 24 hour supervision, and medication management. Timeframe-varies upon individual.
