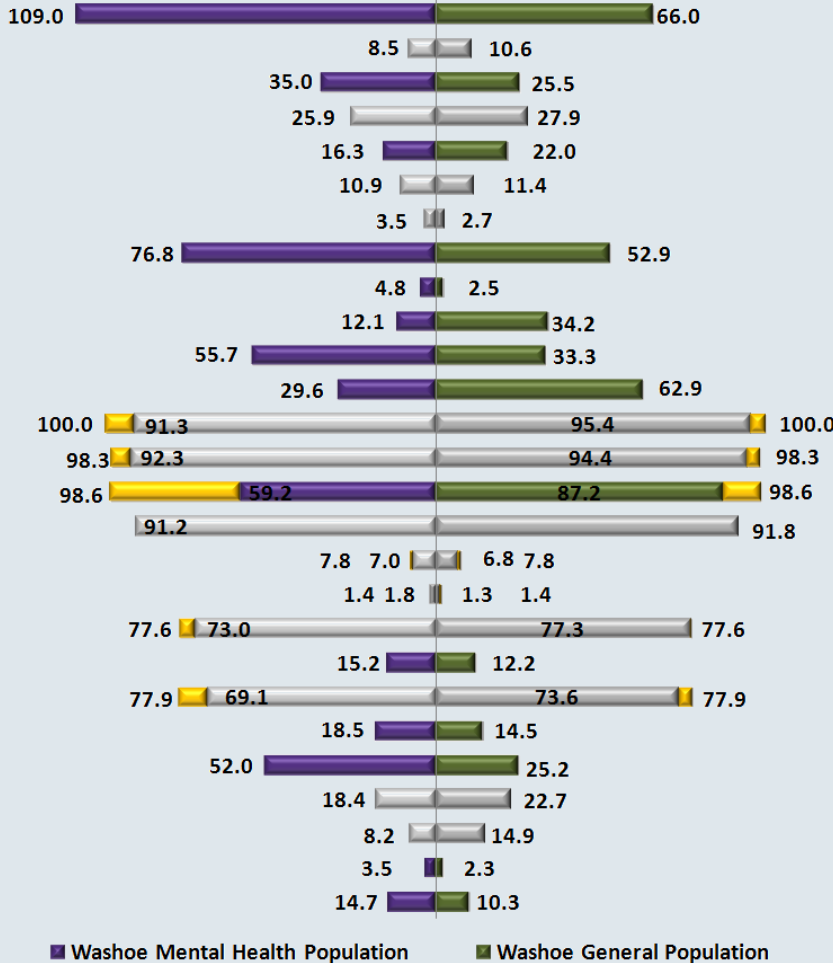
Washoe General Population

6% of women age 15-44 in Washoe County general population give birth each year.



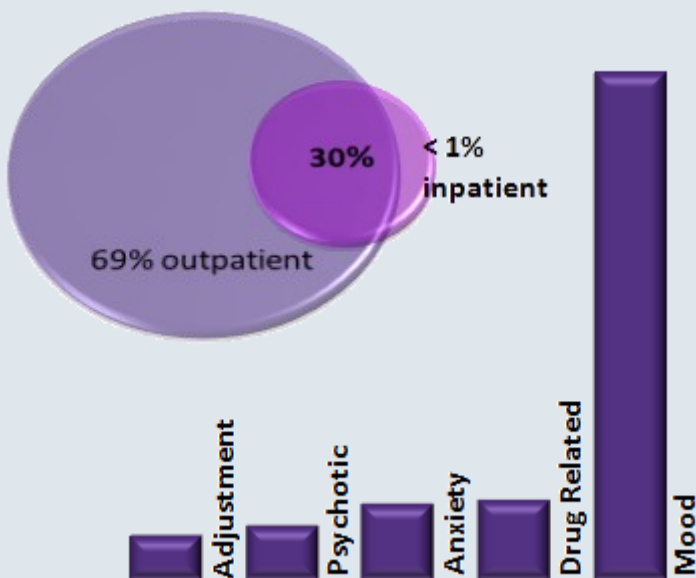
