Medicaid Service Expansion Overview

Outpatient Services:

- Development and reimbursement for Habilitative Day Treatment -1915i/waiver
- Development and reimbursement for Habilitative Intensive Outpatient Services (this would be an expansion of the current service)-1915i/waiver
- Expansion of provider qualifications for Licensed Clinical Drug and Alcohol Counselors (LCDAC) – state plan (already in progress)

Outpatient Services

- Reimbursement for Wrap-Around Services instead of Case Management –state plan/waiver
- Reimbursement for Residential Habilitation – 1915i

Substance Abuse:

- Expansion of provider qualifications for Substance Abuse Agency Model to include non-funded SAPTA –state plan

Rehabilitative Services

- Expansion of provider qualifications and service limitations for Peer to Peer services – state plan
- Reimbursement for Crisis Intervention services under a per member per month (PMPM) model – state plan
- Development of new model of funding/services for Foster Care – non Medicaid

Behavioral Health Services:

Additional research is being done for:

- Reimbursement for Flex Funds
- Reimbursement for Supported Employment
- Reimbursement for Non-Medical Transportation
- Reimbursement for Respite care
