1. Welcome and Introductions

Dena Schmidt called the meeting to order at 1:07 p.m. A quorum was established.

6. Prescription Drug Abuse Prevention Grant Update

Ms. Peek stated that Nevada had been approved to receive funds through the Center for Disease Control (CDC)'s Prevention for States program. Funding for this program has been approved but the notice of award has not yet been received. Once funding has been received, the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) will open a Grants and Projects Analyst position and a Biostatistician position. The Board of Pharmacy (BOP) will also receive funds from this grant that will be used to expand and improve the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP).
