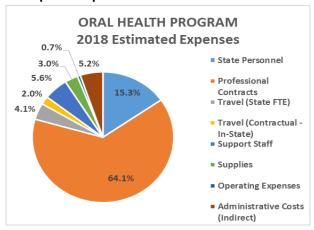

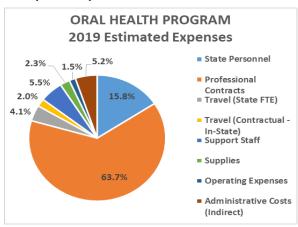
Anticipated Expenses 2018:
