5. Discussion and recommendation on required Cannabinoid and Terpenoid testing profiles (NAC 453A.654)

Savino Sguera recommended a list of Terpenes and Cannabinoids. The list of Cannabinoids and Terpenes was composed based on the availability of proficiency testing for the labs. The Cannabinoids list included THC, THCA, CBD, and CBN. The Terpenes list included; α -Bisabolol, β -Caryophyllene, Caryophyllene Oxide, α -Humulene, Limonene, Linalool, Myrcene, α -Pinene, β -Pinene, and Terpinolene.

Action: Recommend the approval of the proposed Terpenes and Cannabinoids list, provided by Savino Sguera, to be used for testing laboratories.
