### **Crisis Standards of Care Public Engagement Sessions**

*Carson City* – The Division of Public and Behavioral Health (DPBH) is working with healthcare, public health, emergency management, ethical and legal partners to develop Crisis Standards of Care (CSC) Guidance for the state of Nevada. It is vitally important that the public participate in the planning process. During a catastrophic disaster, CSC may need to be implemented to help ensure consistent healthcare across the state. These standards assist healthcare professionals to decide how to provide the best possible medical care when resources are limited.

Four in-person public engagement sessions have been completed so far and three more are scheduled. Anyone who is interested is encouraged to attend.


