Re: Hospital Community Paramedicine Compliance Agreements

NAC 439.280(3), "Schedule for compliance." "In those areas of the State which are not in a health district, or in case of a regulation enforced exclusively by the State Board of Health, the Chief Medical Officer may postpone the enforcement of and agree to a schedule for compliance with the regulation. If the period needed by such a person to comply exceeds 45 days, the schedule must be submitted to the State Board of Health for approval." Request for approval of the Compliance Agreements between William Bee Ririe Hospital, South Lyon Medical Center, Mt. Grant General Hospital, Battle Mountain General Hospital, the State Health Officer, and the Division of Public and Behavioral Health, Emergency Medical Systems Program.

**STAFF REVIEW**

The purpose of the compliance agreements is to allow the Division of Public and Behavioral Health (Division) to approve a community paramedicine service endorsement to a hospital licensed by the Division pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 449. The agreement will allow the hospitals to provide community paramedicine services through their employed or volunteer community paramedicine endorsed Emergency Medical Services providers, until the proposed regulatory amendment(s), Legislative Counsel Bureau File No. R102-18 is approved.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends the Board of Health accept the Compliance Agreements between William Bee Ririe Hospital, South Lyon Medical Center, Mt. Grant General Hospital, Battle Mountain General Hospital, the State Health Officer, and the Division of Public and Behavioral Health, Emergency Medical Systems Program.
