NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Crossroads of Southern Nevada (Charleston Residential Services), has requested a variance from Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 449.74363.3, (Design, construction, equipment and maintenance of facility). NAC 449.74363 states: *"1. Each facility must be designed, constructed, equipped and maintained in a manner that protects the health and safety of the patients and personnel of the facility and members of the general public. 2. Each facility shall comply with all applicable: (a) State and federal laws; (b) Local ordinances, including, without limitation, zoning ordinances; and (c) Environmental, life safety, fire, health and local building codes, related to the construction and maintenance of the facility. If there is a difference between state and local requirements, the more stringent requirements apply. 3. Each facility shall comply with the provisions of NFPA 101: Life Safety Code, as adopted by reference pursuant to [NAC 449.0105](#)."*

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed variance may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may submit written testimony at least five days before the scheduled hearing to:
