Agency Concerns/Issues

DRC ICF has entered into a Systems Improvement Agreement (SIA) with CMS. The SIA was offered by CMS to DRC in November 2017 because of a federal survey that was completed in June 2017. CMS has recognized that DRC would benefit from this agreement to develop and/or improve current processes related to federal requirements. The SIA is in effect till 9/15/18 and requires DRC ICF to contract with a consultant group to assist the facility with meeting federal requirements through root cause analysis activities, action plan, training, technical assistance and ongoing monitoring.
