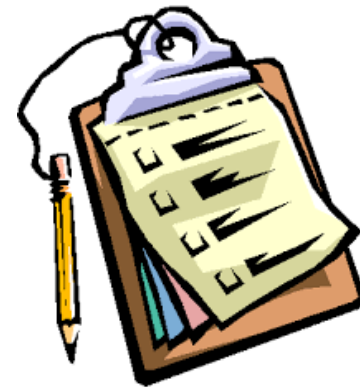

# WHY DO WE HAVE THIS TOOL?

- 2010 HHFKA
  - 2014 Local School Wellness Policy Interim Rule put forth reporting requirements
  
- **Annual-**
  - Website address for each school policy and/or how the public can receive/access a copy of the local wellness policy
  - Description of each schools progress in meeting the local wellness policy goals
  - A summary of each schools events or activities related to local school wellness policy implementation
  - The name, position title and contact information of the school wellness policy coordinator
  - Information on how individuals and the public can get involved with the school wellness policy team
  
- **Triennial-**
  - Indication of the extent to which schools under the jurisdiction of the LEA are in compliance with the LWP
  - Indication of the extent to which the local wellness policy compares to the model school wellness policies
  - Description of the progress made in attaining the goals of the local school wellness policy



# HOW DOES THE TOOL WORK?

- NDA created an online reporting system
- All SFA's were asked to designate a Point of Contact (POC)
- The POC will receive an email with their login information
- They will need to input the district level data
- Once they have submitted this, the school/site level data can be collected

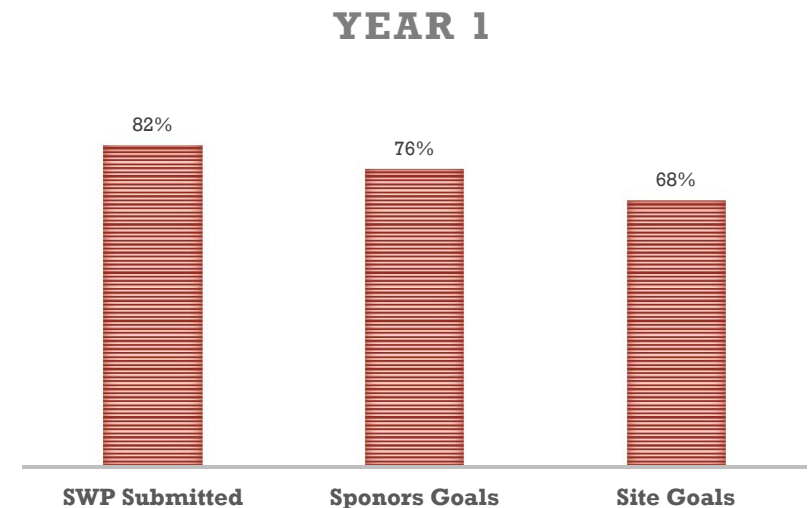

# SUMMARY OF YEAR 1 IMPLEMENTATION

- Total # of SWP's submitted = 27 out of 33 ( 82%)
  - 14 school districts, 4 charters/BIE schools, & 9 RCCI's
- Total # of Sponsors who entered goals = 25 out of 33 (76%)
  - 13 schools districts, 4 charters/BIE schools, & 8 RCCI's
- Total # of Sponsors who had sites that entered goals = 19 out of 28 (68%)
  - 111 sites total



# PLAN FOR YEAR 2 OF IMPLEMENTATION

- In year 2 of 3 for the SWP implementation
- Training
  - S.M.A.R.T. goals webinar to be held soon





# YEAR 2 CONT'D

- Creation of a progress report on year one SWP's, goals made and entered
- Annual questions will be asked in addition to a set of 10 questions asking if goals were met and if the SWP is being followed.
  - Examples:
    - Did your school accomplish this goal?
      - (Yes) If yes, please explain how this was measured.
      - (No) If no, please explain what barriers prevented your school from achieving this goal.
    - Special Occasions
      - Has your school established a policy designating which special occasions or holidays to allow foods and beverages exceeding the Smart Snacks Nutrition Standards?
        - Yes
        - No
        - (Yes) Please list the special occasions.
