To Whom It May Concern:

I have been a Registered Dietitian since 2009, and a Certified Diabetes Educator since 2015. Since 2013 I have been the Diabetes Program Division Manager at the Reno-Sparks Indian Colony's Tribal Health Center, and have had the opportunity to shape the program to best serve our 350 Native American diabetics and reach the 4,500 patients at-risk for Diabetes in the community. Throughout the years I have provided prevention and disease management dietetic counseling, diabetes education, and adult and pediatric obesity management nutrition therapy to those patients. I specifically desired work in an outpatient clinic because I feel prevention is the major key to head off various nutrition-related health conditions. Unfortunately there is a significant nationwide absence of knowledge about general wellness as defined by the CWCD and its link to the prevention of chronic disease.

I feel I am uniquely qualified to serve as a member of the Advisory Council on the State Program for Wellness and the Prevention of Chronic Disease (CWCD) because of this history of a focus on prevention, and how I have applied it to my current work. I have closely followed national and state policies designed to influence public health such as the Fast Food Tax, the Soda Tax, soda sizing limits, incentivized activity, benefit programs for those who prioritize self-care. Subsequently, I have instituted outreach and incentive programs with my Diabetic population to engage patients in the prevention of Diabetes-related neuropathy, retinopathy, and nephropathy. I have also incorporated prevention tools for non-diabetics so they may avoid or delay onset, and targeted the younger population to improve prevention. While these efforts unfortunately target a largely financially challenged population, I feel this work has given me insight into what people respond to and inspires self-care, which could be useful to the CWCD. I recognize the CWCD offers a unique opportunity to help guide policy so concepts of prevention are incorporated into state-supported policy or programs, and I look forward to applying my hands-on experience and education to that challenge.

Good Day:

My name is Margaret Riedl. I am a registered/licensed dietitian and certified diabetes educator with 35 years of experience. I am interested in being considered for the dietitian vacancy on The Advisory Council on the State Program for Wellness and the Prevention of Chronic Disease (CWCD).

I have personally seen the benefits of educating clients with regards to not only disease prevention, but also disease management (diabetes, lipids etc.). Currently, I work with an endocrinologist providing hands on education at each office visit. The frequent interaction with clients provides opportunity for ongoing education with constant feedback and reinforcement resulting in Hemoglobin A1c levels as high as 13 to 15% being reduced to target goals of 7% or less.

Individuals value the education they receive and often they reply that no one has informed me about how to eat to manage diabetes, what an A1c is or what the levels are for good control.

Being at the grassroots levels with clients, it is also amazing and alarming how many individuals have no understanding of their insurance benefits. Often clients do not obtain their medications because of cost and not understanding that the insurance plan they have has large deductibles. Furthermore, clients often cannot take advantage of education opportunities because of the insurance deductibles and/or limited finances. As a result they will naturally choose to use their monies for medications or physician visits over education visits.

I am a firm believer that knowledge is power and the challenge we are faced with today is how to provide the community at large with health information as well as how they can access these opportunities.

I would welcome the opportunity to participate on The Advisory Council on the State Program for Wellness and the Prevention of Chronic Disease (CWCD) to provide hands on client and educator perspective.
