<b>CDPHP Infrastructure &amp; Capacity</b>	
<p><b>Goal:</b> Nevada will have the human resources, leadership, and infrastructure to implement the chronic disease plan.</p> <p><b>FY17 Funding Amount:</b> \$83,713</p> <p><b>Program Timeframe:</b> October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017</p>	
<b>National Health Objective:</b>	<p><b>HO PHI-15 Health Improvement Plans</b>            Increase the proportion of tribal, state, and local public health agencies that have developed health improvement plans and increase the proportion of local health jurisdictions that have health improvement plans linked with their State Plan.</p>
<b>State Health Objective:</b>	<p>Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health's Chronic Disease Prevention and Health Promotion (CDPHP) Section will increase funding, training, and technical assistance to a minimum of 10 organizations needing capacity and infrastructure support.</p>
<b>Activity/Evaluation Objective:</b>	<p>Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will work with community stakeholders to build capacity and increase the number of capacity development opportunities from 0 to <u>2</u>.</p>
<b>FY17 Annual Activities:</b>	<p><b>Activity 1: Chronic Disease Capacity</b>            Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will provide professional development to internal staff through trainings on epidemiology, program planning, care coordination, payment reform, ACA, and program evaluation.</p>

	<p><b>Activity 2: CDPHP Interns</b>  Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will provide internship opportunities to attract students to the public health workforce and to help meet the programmatic and state goals outlined in the 2012-2017 Nevada Chronic Disease State Plan.</p> <p><b>Activity 3: Public Health Accreditation Planning</b>  Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will engage local health authorities to identify and address health problems through a collaborative process of health improvement planning, identifying and implementing strategies to improve access to health care, maintaining and developing a competent public health workforce, implementing quality improvement processes, promoting and understanding evidence-based practices, and building standards as set forth by the Public Health Accreditation Board.</p>

<b>Goal:</b> The provision of community and clinical preventive services in Nevada will be institutionalized with better health outcomes, better care, at lower cost.	
<b>FY17 Funding Amount:</b> \$156,113	
<b>Program Timeframe:</b> October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017	
<b>National Health Objective:</b>	<b>HO ECBP-10 Community-Based Primary Prevention Services</b> Increase the number of community-based organizations (including local health departments, tribal health services, nongovernmental organizations, and state agencies) providing population-based primary prevention services.
<b>State Health Objective:</b>	Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health's Chronic Disease Prevention and Health Promotion (CDPHP) Section will increase access to care from 59% to 68%.
<b>Activity/Evaluation Objective:</b>	<b>CHW Capacity in Nevada</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will increase the number of Community Health Workers (CHWs) trained in Nevada from 125 to <u>200</u> .
<b>FY17 Annual Activities:</b>	<p><b>Activity 1: Community Health Worker Association</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will work in conjunction with community stakeholders to create a Community Health Worker (CHW) Association. This Association will assist with the promotion of CHWs as a workforce and further develop and guide training opportunities.</p> <p><b>Activity 2: Community Health Worker Program Evaluation</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will work in conjunction with the Center for Program Evaluation at the University of Nevada, Reno to produce an evaluation report on the impact of CHWs in Nevada.</p>

<p><b>Goal:</b> Improve the quality of health care delivery through health system interventions and clinical community linkages to populations with the highest burdens of diabetes and/or pre-diabetes in Nevada.</p> <p><b>FY17 Funding Amount:</b> \$63,713</p> <p><b>Program Timeframe:</b> October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017</p>	
<b>National Health Objective:</b>	<p><b>HO D-3 Diabetes Deaths</b> Reduce the diabetes death rate in Nevada.</p>
<b>State Health Objective:</b>	<p>Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, decrease the number of adults in rural, frontier, and metropolitan areas of Nevada who are undiagnosed with diabetes.</p>
<b>Activity/Evaluation Objective:</b>	<p><b>Clinical Linkages for Diabetes Management and Prevention</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, local health authorities will increase the number of clinical community linkages relating to diabetes self-management programs and/or diabetes prevention programs from 0 to <u>1</u>.</p>
<b>FY17 Annual Activities:</b>	<p><b>Activity 1: Establish Referral Between Clinical and Community Settings</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, facilitate infrastructure development to increase access to evidence-based lifestyle change and prevention programs in the community.</p> <p><b>Activity 2: Referral to Diabetes Self-Management</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, facilitate infrastructure development to increase access to evidence-based diabetes self-management education programs.</p>

<b>Heart Disease and Stroke</b>	
<b>Goal:</b> To reduce the proportion of persons with hypertension in Nevada.	
<b>FY17 Funding Amount:</b> \$63,713	
<b>Program Timeframe:</b> October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017	
<b>National Health Objective:</b>	<b>HO HDS-5 Hypertension</b> Reduce the proportion of persons in the population with hypertension.
<b>State Health Objective:</b>	Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, increase the proportion of adults with known high blood pressure who have achieved blood pressure control.
<b>Activity/Evaluation Objective:</b>	<b>Clinical Linkages for Hypertension</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, local health authorities will increase the number of clinical community linkages relating to blood pressure control programs from 0 to <u>1</u> .
<b>FY17 Annual Activities:</b>	<b>Activity 1: Heart Disease and Stroke Prevention Education</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017: create or adapt community-based heart disease and stroke education and blood pressure self-monitoring programs specifically in partnership with health systems; work with local pharmacies to implement blood pressure education and self-monitoring; and/or work with local hospitals to engage Community Paramedics and CHWs to educate and follow patients into the home after discharge to reduce 30-day readmissions.

<b>Increase Physical Activity in Adults and Youth</b>	
<b>Goal:</b> Create a marketing communication plan to promote physical activity in adults and youth in Nevada.	
<b>FY17 Funding Amount:</b> \$54,711	
<b>Program Timeframe:</b> October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017	
<b>National Health Objective:</b>	<b>HO ECBP-10 Community-Based Primary Prevention Services</b> Increase the number of community-based organizations (including local health departments, tribal health services, nongovernmental organizations, and state agencies) providing population-based primary prevention services.
<b>State Health Objective:</b>	Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, decrease the percent of overweight middle school youth from 24% to 23%, obese and overweight high school youth from 24% to 23%, and overweight and obese adults from 60% to 59%.
<b>Activity/Evaluation Objective:</b>	<b>Increase Physical Activity in Adults and Youth</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will maintain <b>7</b> Nevada Wellness media channels and corresponding messaging relating to physical activity, worksite wellness, and obesity prevention.
<b>FY17 Annual Activities:</b>	<b>Activity 1: Media Campaign</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will develop and execute a media campaign for Nevada Wellness related to the promotion of physical activity, worksite wellness, and obesity prevention.

<b>Raising a Healthier Generation</b>	
<b>Goal:</b> Increase physical activity and improve nutrition standards in Early Care and Education settings to decrease childhood obesity in Nevada.	
<b>FY17 Funding Amount:</b> \$74,342	
<b>Program Timeframe:</b> October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017	
<b>National Health Objective:</b>	<b>HO NWS-10 Obesity in Children and Adolescents</b> Reduce the proportion of children and adolescents who are considered obese.
<b>State Health Objective:</b>	Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will work to increase adoption of national standards pertaining to nutrition, physical activity, and breastfeeding practices in Early Care and Education (ECE) settings, to reduce childhood obesity from 3 to 6 standards.
<b>Activity/Evaluation Objective:</b>	<b>Obesity Prevention in Early Care and Education Settings</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section will increase the number of regulations and protocols promoting the adoption of national ECE standards pertaining to physical activity and nutrition from 3 to <u>6</u> .
<b>FY17 Annual Activities:</b>	<b>Activity 1: Obesity Prevention Training &amp; Technical Assistance</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section, in partnership with the Children's Advocacy Alliance (CAA), will conduct training and technical assistance sessions for key stakeholders relating to implementation of the proposed/revised Nevada Administrative Code for Early Care and Education settings. <b>Activity 2: ECE Obesity Prevention Workgroup</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the CDPHP Section, in partnership with CAA, will maintain a statewide workgroup of 5-7 champions focusing on breastfeeding, physical activity, and nutrition that mobilizes around obesity prevention standards in ECE settings. The workgroup's main role will be to implement the statewide Obesity Prevention in Early Care and Education State Plan developed in FY15.

<b>Healthy Relationship Education</b>	
<b>Goal:</b> PHHS block grant set-aside will be used in Nevada to provide workshops for professionals and peer leaders, working with teens and young adults, on healthy relationship education and recognizing dating abuse.

<b>Program Timeframe:</b> October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017	
<b>National Health Objective:</b>	<b>HO IVP-40 Sexual Violence (Rape Prevention)</b> (Developmental) Reduce sexual violence.
<b>State Health Objective:</b>	Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, Nevada Network Against Domestic Violence will provide workshops to professionals and peer leaders on providing healthy relationship education and recognizing dating abuse to youth ages 12-19.
<b>Activity/Evaluation Objective:</b>	<b>Healthy Relationship Education</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, Nevada Network Against Domestic Violence, in coordination with the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health, will provide healthy relationship education workshops for the prevention of intimate partner/relationship violence in teens and young adults to <u>4</u> urban and rural communities.
<b>FY17 Annual Activities:</b>	<b>Activity 1: Educational Workshops for Young Adults</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, the Nevada Network Against Domestic Violence, in coordination with the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health, will conduct educational workshops for adults and peer advocates working with teens to increase healthy relationship education and awareness of intimate partner/relationship violence. <b>Activity 2: Decrease incidents of sexual violence through relationship education</b> Between 10/2016 and 09/2017, develop new strategies to increase awareness of and education on sexual violence issues. Adjust and optimize strategies as needed to deliver the best results.
