Preventive Health and Health Services Block Grant Update (PHHS)**

August 16, 2018

Grant Information:

- A PHHS Public Hearing meeting reviewing next year's work plan was held on June 18th. This work plan stayed similar to the previous year, with the exception that it included incorporating the Obesity Program into PHHS, given the uncertainty of upcoming funding.
- The PHHS Block Grant Coordinator submitted the work plan to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in July. The submitted proposed work plan and budget kept all local health authorities (LHAs) at level funding, with the exception that the "Get Active Elko Project" was not renewed.
- Planning for next year's award is underway.

Evaluation and Reporting:

- Subgrantee quarter 3 reports were due July 16th and technical assistance/evaluation calls will be held with each subgrantee to review.
- Subgrantees include:
 - a. LHAs: Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD), Washoe County Health District (WCHD), Carson City Health and Human Services (CCHHS), and Elko County Health Board (ECHB)
 - b. Non-profits: Children's Advocacy Alliance (CAA) and Healthy Communities Coalition (HCC)
 - c. Health Relationship Education Mandate: Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health Section.
- The in-person Chronic Disease Directors meeting was held on June 1st.
- No CDC reports were due this quarter.
