Overview

- **Timeline**

- October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018

- **Funding Allocation for Nevada**

- \$611,831 (slight increase from previous year)
- 100% of additional funding (\$3,273) is going to partner subawards

- **Seven Objectives**

- CDPHP Infrastructure & Capacity, Community Health Workers, Diabetes, Heart Disease and Stroke, Increase Physical Activity in Adults & Youth, Raising a Healthier Generation, and Healthy Relationship Education

CDPHP Section : Infrastructure & Capacity

- **Goal:** Nevada will have the leadership and infrastructure to implement the Chronic Disease Prevention State Plan.
- **Funded Amount:** \$71,226
- **Partners:** CDPHP Section, Carson City Health and Human Services, Elko County Health Board, and other community organizations
- **Activity:** Continued work internally and with community stakeholders to build chronic disease capacity, infrastructure, health improvement planning, and promote Public Health Accreditation

Community Health Workers

- **Goal:** The provision of community and clinical preventive services in Nevada will be institutionalized with better health outcomes, better care, and at lower costs.
- **Funded Amount:** \$180,108
- **Partners:** CDPHP CHW Program and Healthy Communities Coalition
- **Activity:** CDPHP Section will work with community stakeholders to create a sustainable CHW Association and increase the number of partner linkages to strengthen capacity.

Diabetes

- **Goal:** Improve the quality of health care delivery through health system interventions and clinical community linkages to populations with the highest burdens of diabetes and/or pre-diabetes in Nevada.
- **Funded Amount:** \$72,674
- **Partners:** Southern Nevada Health District
- **Activity:** Continue infrastructure development to increase the number of clinical community linkages relating to diabetes self-management programs and/ or diabetes prevention and early identification through a referral system.

Heart Disease and Stroke

- **Goal:** To reduce the proportion of persons in the population with hypertension.
- **Funded Amount:** \$72,674
- **Partners:** Southern Nevada Health District
- **Activity:** Continue systems development to increase the number of clinical community linkages related to heart disease and stroke self-management programs and/or prevention through a referral system.
**SNHD only receiving 1 subgrant amount to address both this objective and Diabetes*

Increase Physical Activity in Adults and Youth

- **Goal:** Increase and promote opportunities for adults and youth to engage in physical activity at work and in their communities.
- **Funded Amount:** \$76,774
- **Partners:** Washoe County Health District (WCHD) and CDPHP Obesity Prevention Program partnering with Elko County Board of Health
- **Activity:** CDPHP will partner with Elko County's Board of Health for an evidence-based community physical activity initiative. CDPHP Worksite Wellness Program will increase physical activity engagement at DPBH. WCHD plans include policy, systems, and environmental change in parks and open spaces to increase physical activity.

Raising a Healthier Generation

- **Goal:** Increase physical activity and improve nutrition standards in Early Care and Education (ECE) settings as a means to decrease childhood obesity.
- **Funded Amount:** \$77,993
- **Partners:** Children's Advocacy Alliance, ECE Workgroup, and Nevada Child Care Licensing
- **Activity:** CDPHP will continue its partnerships to provide assistance implementing the revised Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) for ECE settings and develop a childhood obesity prevention awareness campaign.

Healthy Relationship Education

- **Goal:** Provide workshops for professionals and peer leaders, working with teens and young adults, on healthy relationship education and identifying signs of relationship abuse.
- **Funded Amount:** \$60,382
- **Partners:** The Rape Prevention and Education Program in partnership with the Nevada Coalition to End Domestic and Sexual Violence (NCEDSV)
- **Activity:** NCEDSV will conduct educational workshops for professionals and advocates working with teens and young adults in rural Nevada and those living with developmental disabilities.
