

SMALL BUSINESS IMPACT STATEMENT 2016

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NAC 440

SUPPLEMENT 09-19-16 (# 6)

The Legislative Counsel Bureau recommended that the Division of Public and Behavioral Health (DPBH) provide a supplement to the Small Business Impact Statement. The supplement does not change the impact on small businesses as the clarification only applies to the county registrars in Clark and Washoe County.

If the proposed regulation provides a new fee or increases an existing fee, the total annual amount DPBH expects to collect and the manner in which the money will be used.

6) The only fee increase is to increase the fee a county registrar pays for the issuance of a death certificate from \$1.00 to \$4.00. The \$4.00 fee has been paid by Clark County and Washoe County for several years, so this increase is to clarify the actual amount paid. No revenue is generated by our office, since \$3.00 goes to the Children's Trust Fund and \$1.00 to the Death Review Committee. This particular fee does not apply to any small businesses. Any new fees are to clarify and lower existing fees due to program changes.
