To: Electronic Death/Birth Registry System Users

This message is to inform you that the Electronic Death/Birth Registry System (EDRS/EBRS) will be unavailable to allow for necessary System Maintenance and Upgrades. This is a planned and coordinated interruption of service to minimize user inconvenience and increase system user friendliness. The details are listed below.

- During the period of system unavailability, users will not be able to log into the system.
- Before the end of the year the State of Nevada, Office of Vital Records' Electronic Death Registry/Electronic Birth Registry System (EDRS/EBRS) will be performing necessary System Maintenance and Upgrades. This could be happening as early as next week.
- There will be 2 separate dates and times where the system will be going offline and will be unavailable.
- The Office of Vital Records will make every attempt to have the shortest period of unavailability possible.
- Many of the upgrades may not be noticeable to users.
- Users may have to re-install system requirements. EDRS Tech Support is available to make this easier.
- Considering the scope of these upgrades, the Office of Vital Records will continue to work with our vendor (Netsmart) to determine if Windows 7 users will still be able to access the system.
  We will notify you as soon as we get more details.
- The dates and times of planned system unavailability will be posted on our website and users notified once the dates and times have been determined.
