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# What is SWAP?



- **System Wide Analytics and Projection**
- **Joint project of Focus Strategies and the National Alliance to End Homelessness**
- **Designed to enable communities to use local data to understand the current system**
- **Model what happens when system and program changes are made**

# Why SWAP?



- **Help communities plan and prioritize changes to bring about the greatest possible reduction in homelessness.**
- **To inform system planning and system change efforts to reduce homelessness over a period of up to 5 years**

# Components of the SWAP Tool



- **9 tabs in the excel worksheet**
  - Data input
  - Investment worksheet
  - Current Outcomes dashboards
  - Current Investment & Costs dashboards
  - Change in PH Exits
  - Change in Lengths of Stay
  - Change in investments
  - Change in Returns to Homelessness
  - Summary snapshots/dashboards

# How to Populate the SWAP



- **Collect data on projects in the CoC or Statewide**
- **Export Housing Inventory Count chart from HMIS or HUD Data Exchange (HDX)**
- **Collect outcome data for projects**
- **Collect project budget data**
- **Review the data for accuracy**

# What will SWAP do for us?



- Model the impact of creating new projects and programs through new investments
- Shows the impact of the efforts that are being made to reduce homelessness while factoring in people becoming newly homeless over time.
- Communities will have specific and targeted strategies to maximize reductions in homelessness with the resources they have

# Southern Nevada CoC and SWAP



- City of Las Vegas has provided an Americorps Vista to collect data and populate the SWAP
- CoC Monitoring Working Group will review for accuracy
- CoC Monitoring and Evaluation Working Groups will use SWAP tool for projections of outcome and resource re-allocation
- Expect that the SWAP will be used for future presentations to the Southern Nevada Homelessness CoC Board
