Introduction

The Nevada Perinatal Network (NPN) is a network established through the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Agency (SAPTA) with the Division of Public and Behavioral Health (DPBH). NPN has been developed to provide a network of agencies and resources to connect those who are dealing with Substance Use Disorders (SUD) and their families. The NPN has put together this resource guide to assist Nevada families in finding services.

This guide will provide information on low cost or no cost residential, transitional, and outpatient treatment agencies, Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) facilities, Women, Infant, and Children (WIC), Medicaid, Welfare, counseling, educational classes, and planning worksheets to help you and your healthcare provider get started on your road to recovery.

Pregnant women with substance use disorders have admission priority at treatment programs that are funded by the SAPTA Block Grant (per 45 CFR Part 96).

Non-profit centers that are funded by the SAPTA Block Grant must not deny substance use treatment to persons unable to pay and may provide sliding scale payment options and serve Medicaid-eligible clients.

Substance Use Disorder

According to Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), “*Substance Use Disorder (SUD) is defined as mild, moderate, or severe to indicate the level of severity, which is determined by the number of diagnostic criteria met by an individual.*” Substance use disorders occur when the recurrent use of alcohol and/or drugs cause clinically and functionally significant impairment, such as health problems, disability, and failure to meet major responsibilities at work, school, or home. According to the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, Fifth Edition (DSM-5), a diagnosis of substance use disorder is based on evidence of impaired control, social impairment, risky use, and pharmacological criteria.

Recovery

SAMHSA defines recovery as a process of change through which individuals improve their health and wellness, live self-directed lives, and strive to reach their full potential. Recovery is built on access to evidence-based clinical treatment and recovery support services for all populations.

The general perception of recovery is the ability to succeed in everyday activities such as work, having a home, relationships and making their own choices. A sense of hope, self-esteem and well-being are also important components of recovery. Without a belief that life will get better, there is unlikely to be any motivation to help oneself. Having a sense of control over one’s life helps a person to feel better about themselves and who they are. The skills and abilities a person develops help them value the contributions they can make. A common denominator of recovery is the presence of people who believe in and stand by the person with SUD.

Though your recovery support network is very important. You are the key ingredient to your recovery.

Develop A Recovery Plan

Take a realistic approach to recovery and develop a plan. Below is a tool to help you navigate the system. There are many first steps you can take to get started depending on your individual needs or wants but the best way to get started is to have an assessment done by your clinician or treatment provider. Your clinician will discuss with you whether or not medication is a good option for you and have them help you develop your recovery plan. Developing a plan allows you to decide where you start. The clinician may

ask you questions such as: what medications you are taking, is there a family history of addiction, what substance are you using and how long have you been using it, are there other conditions such as diabetes or depression, for example. The most important part is that you start. You can use the template provided on the next page or use it as a guide to develop your own plan.

1. Collect important phone numbers and contact information for your support team. This could include your primary physician, your treatment provider, counselor, family and friends or whomever you feel you may need to have contact information for close at hand.
2. Develop your plan. Enter the steps you are going to take to enhance your recovery. This toolkit has resources you can use to get started such as treatment services, financial aid services, and links to additional information on services that interest you. ([Resources](#))

Going Home Planning

Discharge planning (arrangements for care and services after the person leaves a medical or treatment facility) should begin as soon as possible after someone has been admitted. A solid discharge plan will address the services necessary to ensure successful community living once you get home. If someone other than you will be providing ongoing care for you, it is

important that they be included in this planning. The seven main areas essential to a good discharge plan are covered in the worksheet below.

Relapse Prevention

Relapse is common for people with SUD. Relapse does not mean failure. Instead, relapses are opportunities to learn how to better handle the illness. Relapse can occur for a variety of reasons. In some cases, it can occur because of factors outside of anyone’s control.

Relapse Triggers

Many people can identify stressful events, worries or changes in their routine prior to their relapse. It might have been a major change in the person's life such as the death of someone close to them or a number of smaller stresses all coming at the same time. Stressful events or 'negative' situations the person experienced before they became ill may be high-risk events that could trigger a relapse. It is important to identify coping strategies that will help in dealing with high-risk situations. This can help increase the person's confidence that they can stay well in the future. Returning to school in the fall and holidays such as Christmas or spring break are times to watch for warning signs. Triggers of a relapse are individual to the person. Once you have identified potential risk situations, you can then work with your support system to find ways to:

- Identify situations which can be avoided
- Develop coping strategies to deal with the situations that cannot be avoided
- Take steps to deal with problems early on

Medication Assisted Treatment

Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) is the use of FDA approved medications, in combination with counseling and behavioral therapies, to provide a "whole-patient" approach to the treatment of substance use disorders.

Opioid Use Disorder Medications

FDA has approved several different medications to treat opioid addiction and alcohol dependence.

A common misconception associated with MAT is that it substitutes one drug for another. Instead, these medications relieve the withdrawal symptoms and psychological cravings that cause chemical imbalances in the body. MAT programs provide a safe and controlled level of medication to overcome the use of an abused opioid. And research has shown that when provided at the proper dose, medications used in MAT have no adverse effects on a person's intelligence, mental capability, physical functioning, or employability.

Medications used in MAT for opioid treatment can only be dispensed through a SAMHSA-certified OTP. Some of the medications used in MAT are controlled substances due to their potential for misuse. For

Alcohol Use Disorder Medications

Disulfiram, acamprosate, and naltrexone are the most common drugs used to treat alcohol use disorder. None of these drugs provide a cure for the disorder, but they are most effective in people who participate in a MAT program. For additional information go to:
