The Ryan White Part B Program (RWPB) provides medications to low income individuals with HIV, who have limited or no coverage from private insurance, Nevada Medicaid, or who are on Medicare Part D.

RWPB is a payer of last resort. You must update applications every six months to remain eligible for RWPB services. Read more about the program and how to qualify inside this brochure.

## Ryan White Part B Eligibility Criteria

The federal Ryan White CARE Act gives Nevada the authority to determine financial and medical eligibility criteria for participation in the Ryan White Part B Program (RWPB) including ADAP and many other services. Applications must provide specific documentation and demonstrate financial need based on the requirements listed below.

- Documentation of HIV Status
- You must reside in Nevada
- Your income must not exceed 400% of the Federal Poverty Level Guidelines
- You may only have one single owner-occupied home and one automobile
- Your additional assets cannot exceed \$10,000
- You must disclose any existing health insurance policies or availability of coverage through a spouse or significant other
- You must provide a current Government issued photo ID

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
