Summer Food Service Program (SFSP)

The Nevada Department of Agriculture manages the USDA Summer Food Service Program. The purpose of SFSP is to provide food that's in when school is out. The need for healthy nutrition does not end when school lets out for the summer. The Summer Food Service Program fills that gap by providing good, nutritious food at various feeding sites throughout the state. SFSP ensures that children ages 18 years or younger, in low-income areas, can continue to receive nutritious meals during school vacations. The State of Nevada is proud to have received USDA funding for the Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer for Children (SEBTC) program for the summer of 2015.

The mission of the program is to provide nutritional assistance so that children have access to well-balanced and nutritious meals during the summer months when school meals are not available. Students who previously participated and who are currently enrolled in the Free and Reduced Price Lunch Program in Washoe, Douglas and Lyon County School Districts are eligible to participate in the "2015 Summer EBT for Children" Food Program (Please note this is not a school district program and the students were selected at random by a third party.)

This year the program was also expanded to include children enrolled in the Free and Reduced Lunch program in Elko, Humboldt, Lander, Lincoln, Nye, Pershing and White Pine School Districts.
