Describe how DPBH and community partners will work together to improve the health of the population

Provide guidance to DPBH, DHHS, other state and local agencies, community organizations, partners, and stakeholders

Prioritize existing activities and/or set new priorities in key areas; help direct resources; implement projects, programs, and policies

Serves as the foundation from which to take collective action and facilitate collaboration

Why Food Security?

Considerations / Discussion

- Data from the State Health Needs Assessment shows a clear need
 - Impact of the COVID-19 pandemic
- Desire to address issues that contribute to, or are associated with, poverty
- Meets numerous criteria: severity, equity, upstream, impact, momentum, capacity
- Alignment with regional community health improvement plans (CHIPs)
 - Washoe County Health District—Goal: Increase access to healthy food in Washoe County to prevent chronic disease
 - Southern Nevada Health District—increasing access to health foods is integrated in various objectives and action steps
- Enthusiasm about the Department of Health and Human Services' Food Security Strategic Plan 2023

Social Determinants of Health: Food Security

Goal: Reduce food insecurity and improve the overall food security ecosystem in Nevada to help eliminate the hunger gap

Objective 1: Improve collaboration, communication, coordination, and information-sharing among food ecosystem partners.



Objective 2: Increase representation of partners from transportation and housing sectors, tribal communities, and those who have lived experience with food insecurity in decision-making processes related to food security.

Objective 3: Support new strategic partnerships that can assist with transportation needs and efforts to distribute food to people, particularly individuals at increased/ higher risk for food insecurity.



Objective 4: Increase participation in state/federal nutrition programs by individuals experiencing food insecurity and/or who are higher risk for food insecurity.

Next Steps & S

- Finalize goals and objectives
- Finalize and publish SHIP
- Develop action plan for each objective (lead agencies/organizations)
- Compile individual action plans into comprehensive SHIP Action Plan
- Implement action plans (all stakeholders/partners)
- Track implementation and report on progress through DPBH's performance management system
- Review and revise SHIP action plan annually through 2028
