Statistics

- Our gamblers play on average 4 days a week, 5.6 hours a session
- 27% had recent suicide attempts or ideation
- 44% of our clients are totally bet free one year later as compared to the national average of 8-10%
- The Baylor study estimates that the social cost for each problem gambler is \$9,393 per year.
- The Problem Gambler Center's average cost to treat each client is \$1,238.
- The IOP has a direct social and economic impact on the community by reducing gambling-related harms.
- It is a cost-effective treatment program with a positive effect on the well-being of the clients and their loved ones.
