### **VACCINES TO PREVENT INFLUENZA**

The purpose of this resolution is to update the resolution to remove live attenuated influenza vaccine (LAIV) from the VFC program.

VFC resolution 10/12-3 is repealed and replaced by the following:

# **Inactivated Influenza Vaccine (IIV)**

## **Eligible Groups**

All children aged 6 months through 18 years.

### **Recommended Vaccination Schedule**

- 6 months through 8 years: 1 or 2 doses
- 9 through 18 years: 1 dose

### **Recommended Intervals**

Minimum Age: 6 months

Minimum interval between dose 1 and dose 2 (where applicable): 4 weeks

# **Recommended Dosage**
