We began the review with NAC 432A.308 Completion by caregiver of training for recognition of signs and symptoms of illness and administration of first aid.

1-3 No recommendations, everyone was fine.

NAC 432A.310 Staff: Personal health.

Recommendation: change 12 to 24 months

2. a. Mantoux tuberculin skin test; or

2. b. Chest radiograph and examination by a provider of health care who is authorized to diagnose active tuberculosis, within the 12 [24] months immediately proceeding the first day of employment at the facility. **Recommendation:** Add required health evaluations for employees

NAC432A.320 Orientation program and basic training

Recommendation: change Orientation program and basic training to [Program, Policy and Procedure Orientation]

1.f Dealing with occupational health hazards for caregivers including, without limitation, paying attention to the physical health and emotional demands of the job and being aware of any special considerations required by a caregiver who is pregnant.

Recommendation: add – by any care giver who [has been identified any health problems that may affect their job performance including being] pregnant.

1.h.6. Methods for preparing formula if formula is prepared at the facility.

Recommendation: add [Methods for preparing storing and discarding of breast milk.]
