Nevada Medicaid Transportation

The Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is responsible for statewide administration of non-emergency transportation (NET) for Medicaid covered services. Currently, MTM is the non-emergency transportation broker for Nevada Medicaid. In 2019, the DHCFP will publish a request for proposal (RFP) for Medicaid's non-emergency transportation program throughout the state.

Nevada Medicaid Will Be In Your Area

Nevada Medicaid will be hosting town halls throughout Nevada to seek input on the needs and potential barriers with using Medicaid's transportation services. Community participation is appreciated as the information received will be used to develop the request for proposal. All Nevada Medicaid recipients, providers and community partners are invited.

What is Medicaid's NET?

Non-emergency transportation is provided to eligible Nevada Medicaid recipients to obtain medically necessary, Medicaid covered services. Examples of the type of transportation available in-state are fixed bus routes, paratransit, gas mileage reimbursement and door-to-door service when authorized. Out-of-state travel for preauthorized, medically necessary services may include airplanes or trains.

Why is your input important?

Nevada's unique geography can create challenges for rural communities. We hope to gather input from all recipients, providers and community partners to create a non-emergency transportation system that meets the needs of our Medicaid participants.
