Chapter 652 Glucose Testing

Licenses Required

NRS 652.080 requires a license: Exempt Laboratory License & CLIA Certificate of Waiver for glucose tests.

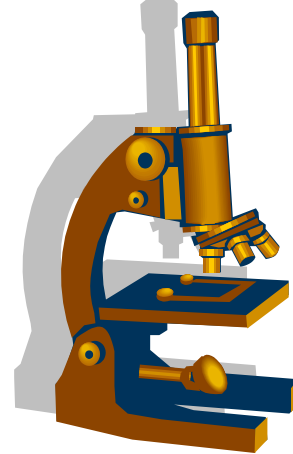
OR

You may refer clients to a reference laboratory, Home Health Agency or clients may perform the testing on themselves, and ***NO LAB LICENSE IS REQUIRED***

Personnel Requirements

1. Director: MD or DO
2. Assistants who are performing tests must be licensed as office laboratory assistants if they are not a nurse.

Next Step



Plan of Action

1. Download the exempt and office laboratory assistant applications from www.health.nv.gov website. Go to Bureau of HCQC, click on Medical Laboratory Services and you will find all the information you will need to apply.
2. Be sure to have the director's signature notarized, that a current copy of their physicians' license is attached to the application and a check or money order is made out to the Nevada State Treasurer.
