Advancing Excellence Campaign

- Mission: make nursing homes better places to live, work, and visit
- Major initiative of the Advancing Excellence in Long Term Care Collaborative
- Assists all stakeholders of long term care
- Helps nursing homes improve the quality of care and quality of life for the more than 1.5 million residents of America's nursing homes by:
 - Establishing and supporting an infrastructure of Local Area Networks for Excellence (LANEs)
 - Strengthening the workforce
 - Improving clinical and organizational outcomes

LANE: Local Area Network of Excellence

- A state-based coalition of key stakeholders who come together to focus on nursing home quality improvement as framed by the goals of the Advancing Excellence Campaign
- The LANE is the central organization within each state that supports participating nursing homes in achieving progress on the 9 Campaign goals and helps the Campaign succeed within the State
- Regular LANE meetings provide a forum for the stakeholders to come together in a way that is unique to each state

The LANE IS:

- A learning network
- Made of partnerships
- A coalition of key nursing home stakeholders
- Collaborative
- Creative

An Advancing Excellence LANE is responsible for:

- Being the Campaign's cheerleader and highlighting the positive aspects of AE
- Inspiring staff in nursing homes to do quality improvement and using the Campaign's Circle of Success as a template for quality improvement
- Providing a way for all partners to connect
- Celebrating successes

Campaign Overview

- Largest national coalition (30 organizations) of nursing home stakeholders working together to help nursing homes improve care
- Voluntary for nursing homes (61.4% or 9,615 NHs registered!) (40 or 78.4% of Nevada homes)
- Based on measurement of meaningful goals
- The data show that the Campaign works!



Registering and Participating

- Registrants: Nursing Homes sign up but don't consistently enter data
- Participants: Nursing Homes demonstrate commitment to principles of performance improvement by entering data
 - Data uploaded onto the website monthly for 6 consecutive months.

Goal Selection and Passwords

Importance of sharing goal selection with the LANE

 Helps the LANE to accurately align their priorities with the needs of the participating nursing homes, such as planning educational opportunities.

AE tools can help NHs with the new QAPI requirements

- New CMS Quality Assurance/ Performance Improvement requirements emphasize
 - problem identification
 - data collection
 - root-cause analysis
 - performance measurement and tracking
- With the shift to MDS 3.0 and the change in quality measures, NHs are more accountable than ever for quality.



Advancing Excellence & QAPI

Use one of AE's Goal "packages" of resources to improve care and become QAPI compliant

- AE's Circle of Success PDSA change framework for systematic performance analysis leading to systemic action (QAPI Element 5)
- Data measurement & tracking tools (QAPI Elements 3, 4 and
 5)
- Root cause analysis tools called "Probing Questions" (QAPI Element 5)
- Consumer, staff, and leadership fact sheets (QAPI Element 2)

AE's Working Hypothesis:

If you have good organizational workplace practices and good care planning practices, the good clinical outcomes will follow and the staff/residents/families will be happy.






How do I know where I am?
