

## Information To Be Submitted By Facilities Proposing to Conduct Healing Arts Screening

Facilities requesting that the Division of Public and Behavioral Health approve a healing arts screening program in accordance with NAC 459.554(3)(b) shall submit the following:

1. Name and address of the applicant and, where applicable, the names and addresses of agents within this state.
2. Diseases or conditions for which the X-ray examinations are to be used in diagnosis.
3. A detailed description of the X-ray examinations proposed in the screening program.
4. Description of the population to be examined in the screening program, i.e., age, sex, physical condition, and other appropriate information.
5. An evaluation of any known alternate methods not involving ionizing radiation which could achieve the goals of the screening program and why these methods are not used instead of the X-ray examinations.
6. An evaluation by a qualified expert of the X-ray system(s) to be used in the screening program. The evaluation by the qualified expert shall show that such system(s) do satisfy all requirements of Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 459 and 457 as applicable.
7. A description of the diagnostic film quality control program.
8. A copy of the technique chart for the X-ray examination procedures to be used for each machine.
9. The qualifications of each individual who will be operation the X-ray system(s).
10. The qualifications of the individual who will be supervising the operators of the X-ray system(s). The extent of supervision and the method of work performance evaluation shall be specified.
11. The name, address and professional credentials of the individual physician who supervises the operation of the machine, who will interpret the radiographs.
12. A description of the procedures to be used in advising the individuals screened and their private practitioners of the healing arts/responsible providers of care, of the results of the screening procedure and any further medical needs indicated.
13. A description of the procedures for the retention or disposition of the radiographs and other records pertaining to the X-ray examinations.
14. Current list of physicians that will accept patients for those patients that do not have a referring physician. The patients must chose a physician from this list prior to obtaining the mammogram.

Note: The Division of Public and Behavioral Health will determine if the request may be granted or if it is subject to the variance procedure of the Board of

Health.
