EDUCATION

- b. Physician's assistant as defined in NRS 630.015; or
- c. Advanced practitioner of nursing as defined in NRS 632.012 with specialty in pediatrics; or
- d. Registered nurse as defined in NRS 632.019; or
- e. Licensed practical nurse as defined in NRS 632.016

EXPERIENCE

2 years (verifiable experience in pediatric nursing)

A director for the care of ill children must be approved by Child Care Licensing.

DIRECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

INSTITUTION DIRECTOR NAC 432A.440(3)

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE

- (a) Possess knowledge of services available for the welfare of children and demonstrate administrative skill and leadership;
- (b) Be a graduate of an accredited college or university and have taken a minimum of 15 credits in the social sciences;
- (c) Have at least 2 years' experience in an administrative or supervisory position in a child care facility; and
- (d) Authorize a member of the staff who is qualified to be a director to act as director in his absence.

The director of an institution must be approved by Child Care Licensing.
