In the Home



In Nevada, the drug misuse rate in our 2017 Health Trends™ report was **69%**, compared to a national drug misuse rate of **52%**.

Drug misuse may include combining prescription drugs with other nonprescribed or illicit drugs, not taking one's prescription medications, or using other drugs instead. The analysis is based on 3.4 million de-identified laboratory tests performed by Quest Diagnostics as ordered by physicians to monitor patients.




In the Workplace



In Nevada, the overall workplace drug positivity rate in 2017 was **4.4%**, compared to the national average of **4.2%**.

Workplace drug positivity is the percentage of individuals whose drug test result indicated a positive result. The analysis is based on more than 10 million workforce drug test results performed by Quest Diagnostics for private and government employers.
