Instructions for Completing the Scope of Work Form (see attached)

1. Type in Name of Coalition/Business Entity
2. Circle the Funding Source: PX, SPI, METH and add fiscal year
3. Type in one CSAP Strategy per line (see enclosed CSAP Strategy and Codes Sheet with description)
4. Type in the Service Code and description identifying the specific strategy
5. Type in one Service Type and Quantity to be completed (see CSAP Strategy and Codes Sheet) and include brief, specific description
6. Type in the *unduplicated* number of individuals to be served at this event/activity
7. Type in Quarter in which the Activity/Event is Expected to Start (1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th quarter)
8. Type in the SAPTA Priorities code(s) this strategy is addressing (See below-multiple entries allowed)

Eight Coded SAPTA Priorities

SPRI 01-Reduce substance abuse related problems in communities

SPRI 02-Build prevention capacity and infrastructure at the state and community levels

SPRI 03-Target substance abuse prevention in Native American communities among youth and in association with suicide

SPRI 04-Develop and/or increase collaboration and partnership with the military; active service, veterans, reservist, National Guard and families

SPRI 05-Focus prevention activities on prescription drugs used illicitly, including drug monitoring programs and prescription drug round-up

SPRI 06-Partner with community-based organizations around marijuana, including medical marijuana dispensaries, legalization issues, and changes in social norms

SPRI 07-Target alcohol and drug use among women of child-bearing years and women currently pregnant

SPRI 08-Prevent the onset of childhood and underage drinking and drug use, reduce the progression of substance abuse, and prevent the relapse of substance abuse of those in recovery
