HARS surveillance statistics includes HIV and AIDS cases diagnosed in Nevada, both living and deceased. The surveillance data excludes HIV/AIDS cases diagnosed in other states, but who currently live in Nevada. HIV Diagnoses and AIDS Diagnoses may duplicate case counts if the person was diagnosed with both HIV and AIDS in 2007.

\*All Other Counties\* includes the counties of Carson City, Churchill, Douglas, Elko, Esmeralda, Eureka, Humboldt, Lander, Lincoln, Lyon, Mineral, Nye, Pershing, Storey, and White Pine.

\*\*NR is the national rate estimate according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC); rates based on 2006 HIV/AIDS data and 2005 population estimates (most recent data available).
