# Overview of CCBHC Requirements

## 10 Core CCBHC Services

- Crisis Behavioral Services
- Screening, Assessment, and Diagnosis
- Person Centered and Family-Centered Treatment Planning
- Outpatient Mental Health and Substance Use Services (medication management, children, adolescent and adults) (not residential)
- Outpatient Clinic Primary Care Screening and Monitoring
- Targeted Case Management Services
- Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services
- Peer Support, Peer Counseling and Family/Caregiver Supports
- Intensive, Community-Based Mental Health Care for Members of the Armed Forces and Veterans
- Assertive Community Treatment Teams



- Staffing Plans in compliance with Medicaid policies and various board of examiners
- Care Coordination
- Ongoing Needs Assessment
- Continuous Quality Improvement
- Board Governance
- Training Plan



# CCBHC Funding Map

- 8 CCBHC's under the Medicaid Plan (Provider Type (PT) 17-188
  - Bride Counseling Associates, Alta and Mcleod, Las Vegas
  - Carson City Community Counseling, Carson City
  - New Frontier Treatment, Fallon
  - Quest Counseling, Reno
  - Rural Nevada Counseling, Silver Springs
  - Vitality Unlimited, Elko and Carson City



# CCBHC Funding Map Continued

- 3 SAMHSA Direct Funded CCBHC's (not included under PT 17-188)
  - Silver State Health, Las Vegas
  - Vitality Unlimited Reno and Dayton
- Request for additional budget authority for CCBHCs under the Medicaid Plan to the Legislature 2023
  - If approved a procurement process will be utilized to determine what CCBHCs not currently included under the PT 17-188 would be added.



# Data Collection

- Billing of services tracked by Medicaid.
  - Fee for Service
  - MCO's
- 21 Quality Measures required to report to state who then reports to SAMHSA. (Data Support)
