**SUBJECT:** New Division Criteria & Program Reporting

The Bureau of Behavioral Health Wellness and Prevention (BHWP) recently updated the Division Criteria used during provider certifications. A newly added requirement titled, "Division Criteria for Certified Treatment Programs Treatment Episode Data Set (TEDS)," states that certified treatment programs, private, public, or SAPTA-funded entities are required to report TEDS to the Division monthly, in a format determined by the Division.

The Division is working on developing communication, reporting instructions, and a proposed implementation plan for all certified entities. Throughout the next year, the Division will be working with certified providers who do not receive State funding to assure all providers can meeting this requirement. Data will not be required to be submitted by unfunded certified providers until notified by the Division. As additional details develop pertaining to this new reporting requirement, the Division will notify all entities.
