CASAT entered a work order with the Division of Public and Behavioral Health, Problem Gambling Bureau of Behavioral Health and Wellness and Prevention to meet the following objectives by June 30, 2020:

- The first draft was released to stakeholders on March 27, 2020. Feedback is being gathered and a 2<sup>nd</sup> draft will be released mid April.
- The roadmap was to be presented at the gambling conference in June 2020, but the conference was cancelled on April 8, 2020. We will look at other options to present the roadmap to the community.

2. Develop and operate 30-hour online problem gambling readiness training.

- CASAT identified contractors in March and received a verbal agreement from those contractors to begin drafting material for the course; however, follow-up has been difficult, in part due to COVID-19, and we are looking at alternative options for course development.

3. Begin developing the infrastructure to create and house a liaison service that will assist individuals in gaining CPCG-I and CPCG in Nevada.

- The infrastructure will include a job description, proposed salary and FTE.

CASAT plans to meet the deliverable by engaging community members, stakeholders, and the State of Nevada Board of Examiners for Licensed alcohol, drug and gambling counselors in continued conversation of what they feel is needed in the position, how the position can best serve individuals interested in becoming problem gambling counselor interns, and how the position can promote pathways to become a problem gambling counselor intern.
