Strategic Plan Review & Update Process

- The Strategic Plan is considered a living document that is revised as needed.
 - The FY2020 & FY2021 Plan has undergone revisions and will continue to do so.
 - Version 1.0 was reviewed and approved by the ACPG in December 2018
 - Version 2.0 was created in response to a June 2019 legislative budget increase allowing for program expansion
 - Version 2.5 was release in March 2020 in response to COVID-19 related emergency measures to meet treatment needs
 - Version 3.0 is anticipated to be created in Summer of 2020 in response to possible FY2021 budget changes.

Strategic Plan Version 2.5 Updates

- Telehealth policy
 - Added Exhibit 6: Telehealth Counseling Policy Statement/Guidelines
 - Added procedure code specifier to track telehealth service provision (i)
 - Created a new “Program Development” (DEV) add-on code
 - Increased flexibility for gambling treatment providers to use add-on code funds for program development needs.
 - Increased “add-on” code claim allowance from 10% of total grant award to 20%

Strategic Plan Version 3.0 Concepts

- With stable or added funding for treatment
 - Expand aftercare services by adding procedure codes for drop-in counseling
 - Develop peer delivered services by adding procedure codes and workforce development opportunities
 - Others TDB
 - With funding reductions
 - May need to revise client benefit caps and/or “add-on code” allowances
 - May need to revise scope of services for several program areas
 - Will likely need special ACPG meeting to seek service adjustment recommendations
