## **NEVADA WEBIZ HAS A PUBLIC ACCESS PORTAL!**

Nevada WebIZ is a confidential online Immunization Information System (IIS) used statewide by doctors and nurses to keep track of their patients' immunizations. Through the Public Access Portal website:


- Parents and legal guardians can print official immunization records for their child(ren) (ages 0 through 17 years), and
- Adult individuals (ages 18 years and over) can print an official immunization record for themselves.

This is an official record and can be used as proof of immunization for school entry, summer camp, employment, etc.

## Six Easy Steps to Finding a Record Through the Public Access Portal

- 1) Ask your doctor to update your email address and cell phone number on your and/or your child(ren)'s Nevada WebIZ record.
- 2) Visit the Public Access Portal at:

- 4) Select whose record you are seeking (*Me* or *Dependent*), then enter the Last Name, First Name, Date of Birth, and Gender of the person whose record you are searching for.
- 5) Verify your identity by selecting where you would like the Access Code sent (*Mobile Phone* or *Email Address*) and enter the mobile phone number or email address.
- Enter the Verification Code in the text box on the next screen and select Verify.
- 7) Download and save/print the Official Immunization Record, COVID-19 Record, or COVID-19 QR Code (Adobe .PDF format) to have for your records.
