Attachment 1	A copy of the permit issued by your local health authority showing approval of the source water(s) and the bottling plant.
Attachment 2	A report by the applicant regarding past compliance with the applicable regulations on the quality and sampling of the water produced and distributed. A copy of the most recent inspection is acceptable.
Attachment 3	A copy of the recent, complete chemical analysis of the source water(s), and finished product, including inorganic chemicals, chlorinated organic chemicals, volatile organics, synthetic organic compounds, herbicides and pesticides, radioactive elements, and asbestos, according to NAC 445A.555 (www.leg.state.nv.us/NAC).
Attachment 4	Copies of the three (3) most recent bacteriological tests for each product.
Attachment 5	Label Application: Samples of all most recent label(s) for product(s) currently produced by the company for distribution in Nevada. Label review fee(s) in the amount of \$83.00 will apply for EACH new / modified product label. This completed application form and remittance of the label review fee of \$83.00 per NEW or MODIFIED label payable to the Nevada State Health Division.

Permits are not transferable. Approval of this application and issuance of an Environmental Health Permit is required before commencing operation. Failure to obtain both may result in closure. The undersigned applicant agrees to operate in accordance with all applicable state, federal and local laws.
