

Compliance Agreement
Division of Public and Behavioral Health and CCHHS-Community Health Clinic

This Compliance Agreement is made and entered into effective on May 14, 2020, by, between, and among the Bureau of Health Care Quality and Compliance of the Division of Public and Behavioral Health of the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services of the State of Nevada (“BHCQC”), CCHHS-Community Health Clinic (“Laboratory”), the State Board of Health (“Board”).

RECITALS

The goal is to define the criteria for compliance for CCHHS-Community Health Clinic (Exempt Laboratory #4616) located at 900 E LONG ST, CARSON CITY, NV and the State Board of Health (“Board”).

A. NAC 652.195 allows a licensed laboratory to collect specimens or perform tests, or both, at a location other than the location set forth in its license by obtaining a permit to operate a laboratory at a temporary location.

B. Due to the COVID-19 outbreak and the need to serve rural underserved counties with WAIVED COVID-19 testing services, CHHS- Community Health Clinic, an exempt laboratory, will be allowed to operate at locations other than the location set forth in its license without a permit and without being a licensed laboratory at the following locations:

- Friends in Service Helping Medical Clinic, 160 E Long St, Carson City, NV 89701
- The Bridge Church, 901 S Carson St, Carson City, NV 89701
- Carson Valley Community Food Closet, 1251 Waterloo Ln, Gardnerville, NV 89410
- Friends in Service Helping – Ranchos, 921 Mitch Dr, Gardnerville, NV 89460
- Silver Springs Senior Center, 2945 Ft Churchill, Silver Springs, NV 89429
- Yerington Senior Center, 117 Tilson Way, Yerington, NV 89447
- Dayton Senior Center, 320 Old Dayton Valley Rd, Dayton, NV 89403
- Fernley Senior Center, 1170 W Newlands Dr, Fernley, NV 89408
- Storey County Senior Center, 100 Mill St, Virginia City, NV 89440
- Storey County Senior Center, 800 Peri Ranch Rd, Lockwood, NV 89434

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed as follows:

- C. **State Licensure.** The Laboratory falls under the provisions of Nevada Administrative Code (652).
- 1) The laboratory will be allowed to perform WAIVED COVID-19 testing in the rural underserved counties documented in B. without obtaining a permit and without being a licensed laboratory.
 - 2) The laboratory must remain in compliance with NRS 652.072; therefore, the patients served in the locations other than the locations set forth in its license would be patients of the laboratory director.
 - 3) The laboratory must still submit an addition of test application to the Division of Public and Behavioral Health.
- D. **Term of Agreement.** This Agreement shall remain in effect until the chief medical officer terminates this agreement

Requirements. Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, the Laboratory will maintain compliance with all applicable provisions of NAC Chapter 652.
