I was advised this evening by constituents of the Nevada Board of Health emergency meeting scheduled for this Friday, 20 August to discuss and vote on a mandatory vaccination requirement for all students enrolled in a Nevada public university or college if they wish to attend classes in person. Should my understanding of the Board's action be correct I wish to go on the record objecting to such action. My objection is based two fold. First the decision should be made by the Board of Regents who are responsible for the operations of the institutions. Secondly, it seems grossly unfair to the students to make such a policy since they are already enrolled and studies are in progress. The pandemic and related information being outlined in your discussion for several months now and should be vetted in a more reasonable manner.
