I am a faculty member in nursing, and I am trying to stay updated on the Covid-19 pandemic.

Here are my comments:

--students who have had a Covid infection and/or show a positive titer for antibodies or proof of immunity, should not have to show proof of vaccination. They may have better immunity than those who take the vaccine.

--there must be medical exemptions to the vaccine. Students have medical conditions, pregnancy, etc. that may be contraindications to vaccine.

--there also should be exemption for religious reasons.

--weekly Covid tests should not be required.

POINT: people who have been vaccinated are increasingly getting sick with Covid-19. The vaccine is not the end of the pandemic. Most important is self-monitoring and self-isolation with symptoms so as not to put others at risk. And protecting the vulnerable.
