I am a faculty member in nursing, and I am trying to stay updated on the Covid-19 pandemic. Here are my comments:

- --students who have had a Covid infection and/or show a positive titer for antibodies or proof of immunity, should not have to show proof of vaccination. They may have better immunity than those who take the vaccine.
- --there must be medical exemptions to the vaccine. Students have medical conditions, pregnancy, etc. that may be contraindications to vaccine.
