The vaccine is approved for emergency use only and federal law forbids mandating it, in accordance with the Nuremberg Code of 1947. You may also find yourself with a substantial liability risk if a student suffers injury from being forced to take the vaccine. There are lawsuits being filed all over the country. The Supreme Court did not issue a decision that vaccine mandates are legal. Ms. Barrett declined to refer the case to the full court. This is far from over.

This virus has a 99% recovery rate especially for younger people. Asymptomatic transmission is very rare according to Dr. Fauci so perhaps your efforts should focus on encouraging students and teachers with symptoms to stay home.
