Board of Health:

I would like my comments to be added to the minutes of the meeting.

Board members:

Since Covid 19 appeared Dec 2019, there have been strides in treatments that render this pandemic null and void. People may be getting sick from variants, and may be going to the hospitals but most are not dying anymore. Very few people die from covid today.

People who have had covid have a natural immunity to getting covid again or any variants. People who are vaccinated are not immune from getting sick or dying either. So, to mandate students get the shot so they can attend in person doesn't help them from getting sick or crowding hospitals any more than if they were unvaccinated.
