## EMERGENCY REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH

Explanation – Language in *blue italics* is new.

AUTHORITY: NRS 439.265

Section 1. NAC 439.895 is hereby amended as follows:

Except as otherwise provided in <u>NRS 439.265</u> or other specific statute, the information included in the System is confidential and access must be limited to:

1. A provider of health care as defined in <u>NRS 439.820;</u>

2. The Nevada System of Higher Education or a private college or university authorized to operate in this State;

3. A child care facility as defined in <u>NRS 432A.024;</u>

4. Public schools and private schools as defined in <u>NRS 385.007</u> and <u>394.103</u>, respectively;

5. The Department;

6. An insurer as defined in <u>NRS 679B.540</u>, regardless of whether the insurer directly covered the immunization;

7. An agency which provides child welfare services as defined in <u>NRS 432B.030;</u> [and]

8. The Department of Corrections[-]; and

9. For information in the System relating to the SARS-CoV-2 immunizations, and for the limited purpose of ensuring occupational safety of State of Nevada employees, and subject to the confidentiality provisions set forth in <u>NAC 284.726</u>, subsection 4, the director of the department or equivalent executive head, the human resources point of contact, and their designees, of each Executive Branch department and each Executive Branch constitutional office except information pertaining to individuals serving the State of Nevada in a limited capacity as a member of a board or commission.

 $\rightarrow$  For purposes of this section, "limited capacity" means the member does not perform any services for the State other than occasional participation in meetings.

The Board of Health has made a finding that an emergency affecting the health and safety of the public exists, and that adoption of the Emergency Regulation is appropriate.
