ACTIONS SINCE MARCH BOH MEETING

- Received approval from the Governor and Interim Finance Committee to assume environmental health and services under NRS 441A for the 4-county region.
- Agreed to a structure with an administrator and a contractual health officer.
- Drafted job descriptions for the administrator and directors of each division.
- Ongoing meetings with DPBH to ensure a smooth transition of services and to have discussions on distribution of grant funding.
- Developed an operational plan to keep us on track.
- Held meetings in each community to inform public of the vision and progress.
- Drafting interlocal agreements needed for the District.



ACTIONS, CONTINUED

- Drafted a budget
- Regular updates at the individual counties BOH meetings.
- In the process of implementing county codes to abolish their county BOH and joining the District.
- Preparing for the first District BOH meeting (December 8th pending approval)
 - Bylaws
 - Appointment of Officers and appointment of a physician
 - Approval of interlocal agreements
 - BOH orientation

- The City of Fallon has joined in as a full partner in the District.



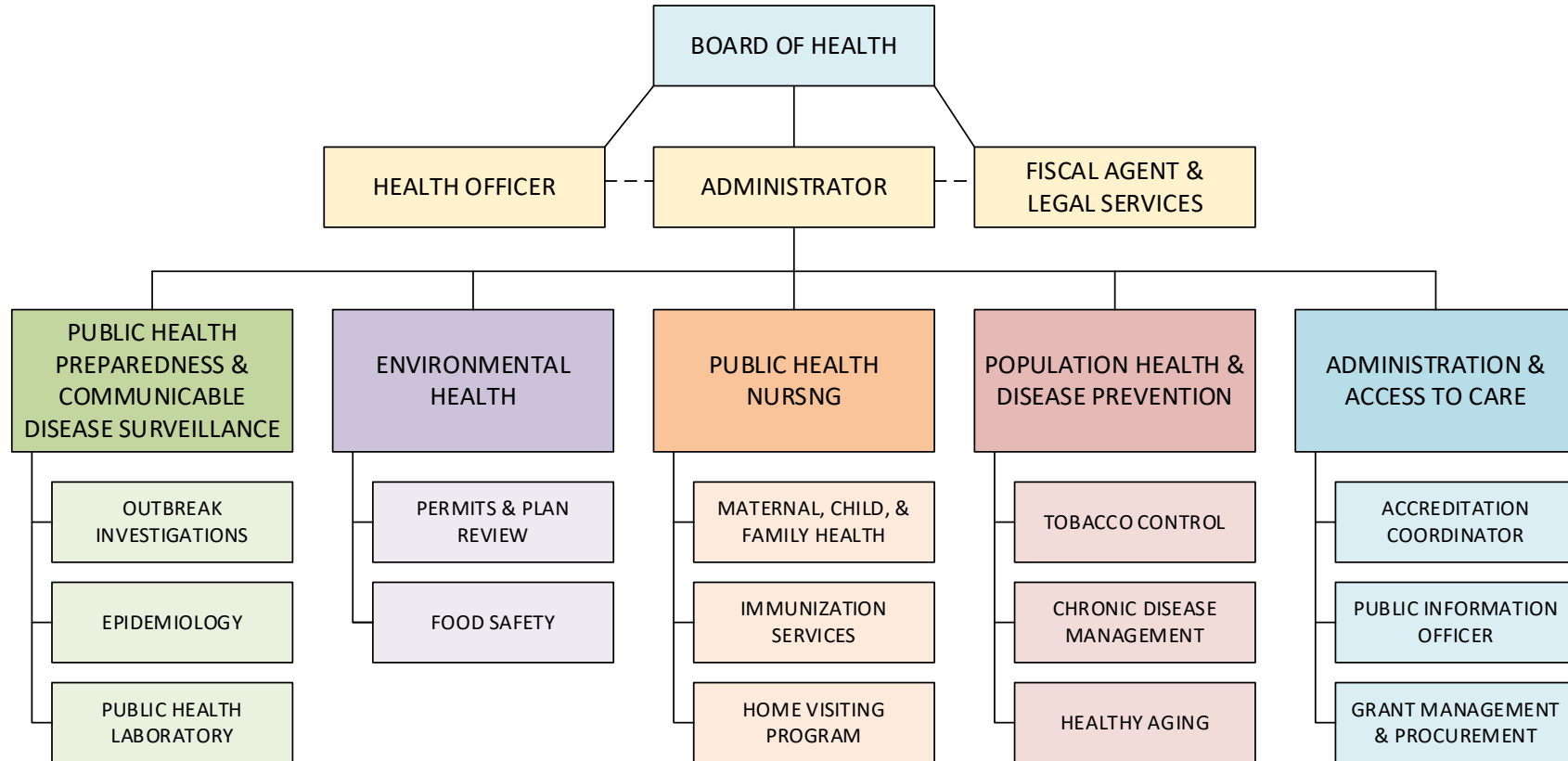
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SNAPSHOT OF SERVICES TO BE OFFERED

- Public health preparedness
 - Develop all hazards plan
 - Disease investigation
- Environmental health services
 - Restaurant, pools, spas, hotels, schools, RV parks, Burning Man
- Clinical services
 - Immunizations
 - Family planning
 - Home visits
 - Services will be tailored to the needs of the communities being served
- Population health management
 - Community health workers in each area



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FUNDING TO DATE

- Grants
 - Workforce
 - ARPA funds
 - Other grants from the DPBH to be determined
- Developed a formula for a county/city to “buy-in:”
 - \$100,000 flat fee for each entity
 - \$5.00 per capita
- Counties/city will also add 20% of their “buy-in” to develop a contingency fund. The goal is to reach a base of \$200,000 for that fund.
