The licensed laboratory director who accepts the responsibility of being the laboratory director of a Licensed laboratory performing waived glucose testing by Certified Nursing Assistants and students enrolled in an accredited school of professional nursing or a graduate of such a school pending the results of the first licensing examination scheduled by the State Board of Nursing following graduation, will be required to ensure that the individuals

have applied for and obtained their Point-of-Care analyst laboratory personnel license from the BHCQC and maintain documentation of training and competency.

C. <u>Term of Agreement.</u> This Agreement shall remain in effect until such time as the provisions in NAC Chapter 652 have been changed to allow Certified Nursing Assistants and students enrolled in an accredited school of professional nursing or a graduate of such a school pending the results of the first licensing examination scheduled by the State Board of Nursing following graduation to be licensed by the State of Nevada as Point-of-Care analysts, or until the State Chief Medical Officer terminates this agreement.
